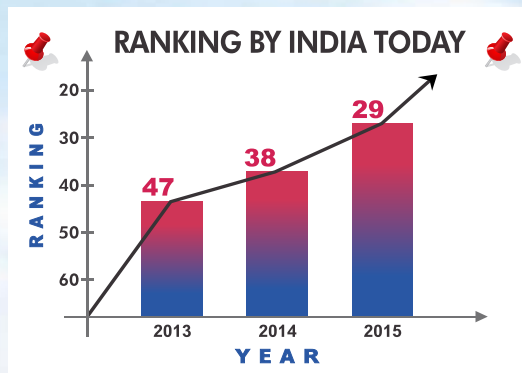

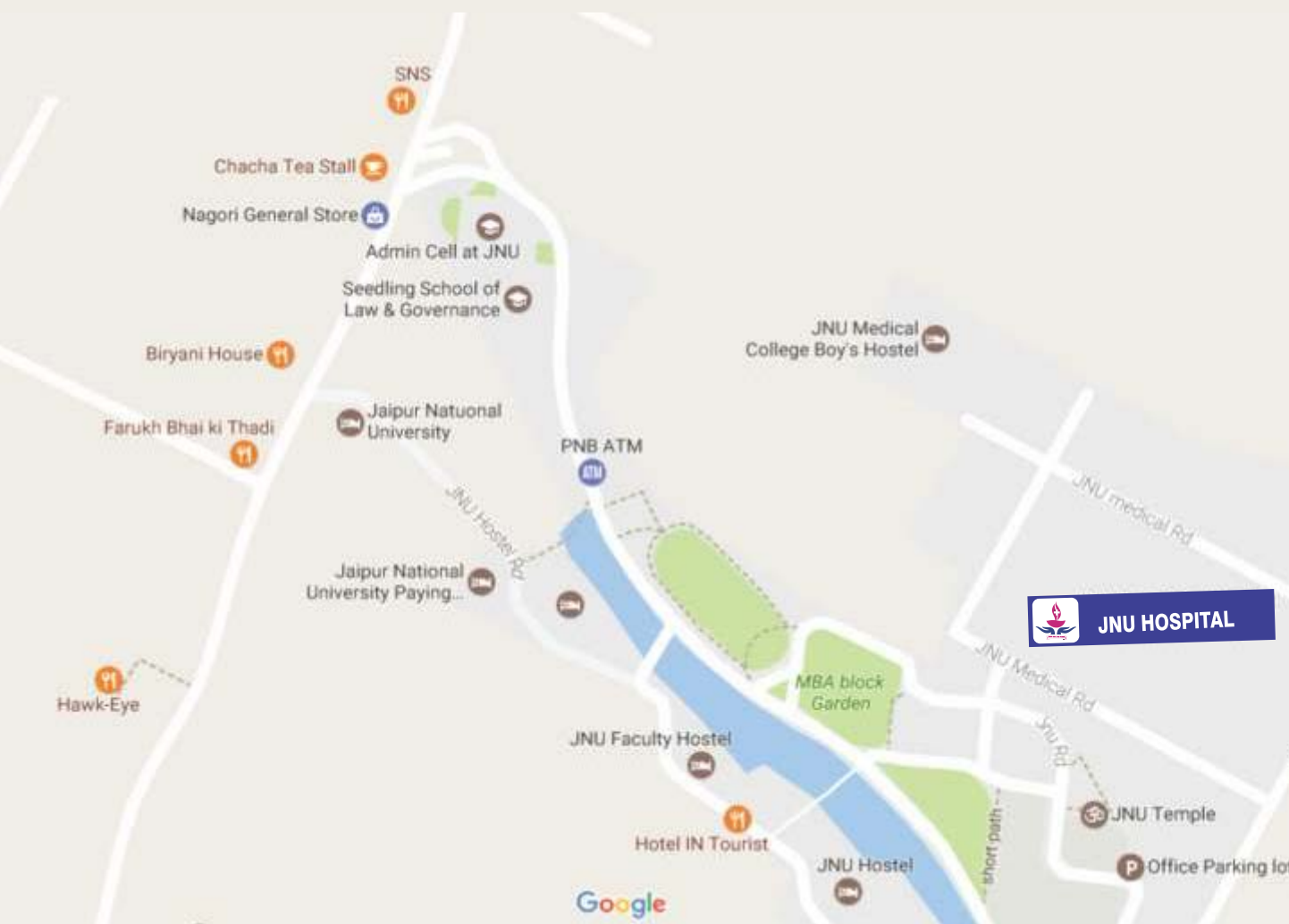

# MEDICAL COLLEGE – INFRASTRUCTURE

The College building houses 8 (eight) preclinical & para-clinical departments, Lecture Theatres & Central Library.



**Anatomy:** The department consists of a well stocked Museum which has more than 150 Wet Specimens, Models, Skeletons, Radiographic & Embryology models, Research Lab, Dissection Hall & Histology Lab.



**Physiology:** The department boasts of its state-of-art facilities, like Hematology Lab, Clinical Physiology Lab, Exp. Physiology Lab, & a Research Lab.



**Biochemistry:** The goal of teaching Biochemistry to first MBBS Students is to make them aware how life processes deal with different chemicals, whose derangements cause various disorders. The department is well equipped with Biochemistry Lab & a research Lab to perform basic Biochemical analysis relevant to Clinical Testing, Diagnosis & interpretation of results.



**Pathology:** The department has well equipped Histopathology Lab, Cyto Pathology Lab & a Museum which houses more than 150 wet specimens, models, & charts. Apart from that, the department has Service Laboratories in the Hospital & an ultramodern upgraded Blood Bank with modern technology.







**Microbiology:** Microbiology is a wide & deep branch including various disciplines like Bacteriology, Mycology, Parasitology, Serology, Immunology & Virology. The department is well equipped with well established Laboratory, Museum & a Library to facilitate student's grasp and understanding of the subject.



**Pharmacology:** The department boasts of Experimental Pharmacology & Clinical Pharmacology & Pharmacy Labs along with a Museum & a rich Library. The well trained faculty aims to inculcate a rational & scientific basis of pharmacotherapeutics. Practical knowledge of use of Drugs in Clinical practice will be acquired through integrated teaching with clinical & pre-clinical departments.



**Forensic Medicine:** The department is well equipped with forensic Topology Lab. We are also recognized as a Medico Legal Centre by Government of Rajasthan. The department also provides favourable outcome for conducting scientific research with the beneficial practical outcomes & provides world Class Training in Medico Legal issues & medical jurisprudence.



**Community Medicine:** Community Medicine is the art of preventing disease, prolonging life & promoting physical & mental health of the Community as a whole. The Community medicine department is equipped with State-of-Art Research lab, Museum & Library. The department also has an Urban Health Training Centre & Rural Health Training Centre to impart training in basic medical care at community level to undergraduate students.



# LECTURE THEATRES

The most prominent seat of learning in an Institute are its Lecture Theatres. Here in our institution we have lecture theatres well equipped with ultramodern facilities of air-conditioning, sound proofing, Dolby sound system with comfortable seating arrangement for 200 students. These are fitted with Audio-visual facilities like: LCD projectors, over head projectors, Wide-Screen, Collar-mikes and other tools of e-learning. Three more lecture theaters are coming up, (2 in the college & 1 in the hospital), one of these will accommodate an audience of 400.





# CENTRAL LIBRARY

JNUIMSRC has well stocked central library with stocking area for more than 11000 books and National and International Journals, Internal and external reading room for staff and students, skill development lab, computer lab with 40 computers with Internet facility and computer simulation programmes for undergraduate teaching.

## Goals of Medical Graduate Training Programme

### NATIONAL GOALS:

At the end of undergraduate programme, the medical student should be able to:

- (a) recognize 'health for all' as a national goal and right of all citizens and by undergoing training for medical profession fulfil his/her social obligations towards realization of this goal.
- (b) learn various aspects of National policies on health and devote himself/herself to its practical implementation.
- (c) achieve competence in practice of holistic medicine, encompassing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative aspects of common diseases.
- (d) develop scientific approach, acquire educational experience for proficiency in profession and promote healthy living.
- (e) become exemplary citizen by observance of medical ethics and fulfilling social and professional obligations, so as to respond to national aspirations.

### INSTITUTIONAL GOALS:

At the end of the undergraduate curriculum at **JNUIMSRC**, in addition to the national goal, the student should be:

- (a) competent in diagnosis and management of common health problems of the individual and the community, commensurate with his/her position as a member of the health team at the primary, secondary or tertiary levels, using his/her clinical skills based on history, physical examination and relevant investigations.
- (b) competent to practise preventive, promotive, curative and rehabilitative medicine in respect to the commonly encountered health problems.



- (c) able to appreciate rationale for different therapeutic modalities, be familiar with the administration of the "essential drugs" and their common side effects.
- (d) able to appreciate the socio-psychological, cultural, economic and environmental factors affecting health and develop humane attitude towards patients in discharging one's professional responsibilities.
- (e) Possess attitude for continuous self learning and to one's further expertise by pursuing research in any chosen area of medicine.
- (f) Should be familiar with the basic tenets essential for the implementation of National Health Programmes including practical aspects of the following:
  - (i) Family Welfare and Material and Child Health(MCH)
  - (ii) Sanitation and water supply
  - (iii) Prevention and control of communicable and non-communicable diseases
  - (iv) Immunization
  - (v) Health Education
- (g) able to acquire basic management skills in the area of human resources, materials and resource management related to health care delivery.
- (h) able to identify community health problems and to resolve these by designing and instituting corrective steps and evaluating outcome of such measures.
- (i) able to lead, facilitate and/or work as a leading partner in health care teams and be proficient in communication skills.
- (j) competent to work in a variety of health care settings.
- (k) have personal characteristics and attributes required for professional life such as personal integrity, sense of responsibility, dependability and empathy.





# REGULATIONS

## Regulations for Admission to MBBS Course

- (i) **Medical Council of India Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997 & Amendments.**
- (ii) **The Regulation on Graduate Medical Education Amendment, January 2016 & Amendments.**

### NUMBER OF SEATS - 150

#### Duration of the Course

Duration of the MBBS course is 4½ years as per the Academic Calendar of JNUIMSRC and MCI, followed by one year of Compulsory Rotatory Internship for the award of Degree.

#### Eligibility Criteria for Admission to MBBS Course at JNUIMSRC

##### 1. AGE

- a) He/she has completed age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete the age on or before 31st December of the year of his/her admission to the 1st year MBBS Course.
- b) The upper age limit for NEET is 25 years as on the date of examination with relaxation of 5 years for candidates belonging to OBC/SC/ST category. (As per letter no. U.12023/16/2010-ME-II dated 17.01.2017 received from MOH&FW)

The Age criteria for appearing in NEET (UG), 2017 is as follows:

For Candidates of Unreserved Category (UR)	born on or between 08-05-1992 and 01-01-2001
For Candidates of SC/ST/OBC Category	born on or between 08-05-1987 and 01-01-2001

**2. Academic Qualification** - The applicant should have passed the qualifying examinations in the manner mentioned below:

- a) The Higher / Senior Secondary Examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher / Senior Secondary Examination after a period of 12 years of study, the last two years of such study comprising Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology (which shall include practical tests in these subjects) or any other elective with English at a level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the National Council of Educational Research.
- b) The applicant must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology at the qualifying examination and competitive entrance examination. For candidates belonging to the





Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes and ORTHOPEDIC PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED, the marks obtained in the Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology taken together in the qualifying examination and competitive entrance examination is 40% and 45% respectively.

c) Reservation Policy on seats allotted through NEET will be applicable as per the guidelines of the Government of Rajasthan. No Reservation is applicable on NRI seats.

### **NRI SEATS**

1. Overseas citizen of India means as follows: OCI registered under section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955. The candidate will submit proof of Registration as OCI under section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 along with the application to be eligible for admission to MBBS course. Certificate of registration as OCI issued by the Competent Authority should be produced at the time of admission.

2. According to admission regulatory committee of the Government of Rajasthan (as per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India) in NRI quota description of 'ward' - an NRI who undertakes to sponsor a student for admission as guardian need not be a blood relation. Hence the 'ward' in case of NRI admission means a candidate whose guardian is a bonafide NRI.

3. (i) A candidate shall be Non-Resident Indian, or

(ii) His / Her parents or in absence of his / her parents, his / her legal guardian shall be non-resident Indian, or

(iii) He / She shall be dependent of Non-Resident Indian for the educational purposes and shall have necessary proof/ evidence in support of his dependency.

4. Foreign students from other countries should possess passport, visa and exchange permits valid for the period of their course of study in this Institution and should also observe the regulations of both central and state governments regarding residential permits and obtain no-objection certificate.

5. The candidate should have a provisional "Student Visa", if he / she comes on any other visa and is selected for admission, he / she will have to first obtain a student visa from his / her Country and then

only he / she will be allowed to join the course. Therefore it is imperative to obtain provisional students visa before coming for admission.

6. NRI candidates are required to have qualification as per MCI guidelines to be eligible for admission to the MBBS course.

### **SELECTION AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- Admission to 85% seats of the total intake capacity will be granted on the basis of merit obtained by the candidates at NEET 2017.

- Admission to 15% seats, i.e, NRI seats will be granted as per the MCI & other statutory guidelines to be eligible for admission to the MBBS course.

- No admission shall be made beyond 30th September or the cutoff date of the academic year.

- The date of commencement of classes shall be as per the schedule of the MCI and other regulatory bodies. In cases, where the student has been admitted to the course after the commencement of classes through waiting list or otherwise on or before 30th September of the academic year, the period of training and duration of the course will be reckoned from the date of commencement of the classes in August and not from the date of his actual admission.

### **CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL FROM THE COURSE**

The admission of the student, who has paid the admission fees but fails to join the course at the institute within the time limit communicated, is liable to be cancelled and the tuition fees paid will neither be refunded nor be transferred. Only items mentioned as deposits (Interest free refundable amount) will be refunded.

### **LEGAL JURISDICTION**

All disputes in relation to the matters pertaining to the admissions in the course shall be subject to the territorial jurisdiction of courts at Jaipur (Rajasthan) having jurisdiction to try the issues.





# Guidelines & Instructions

## for filling in the Application Form

- The Prospectus and the application form can be downloaded from the University website ([www.jnuhealthcare.com](http://www.jnuhealthcare.com)). The filled application form shall be accepted only with the cost of the application form amounting to Rs 5000/- or USD 100 (to be deposited in the University Accounts Department or through Bank Draft / RTGS / Wire-in transfer in favour of **Jaipur National University Institute for Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Jaipur, Payable at Jaipur**).
- The application form is required to be completed by the applicant himself /herself.
- Application form fee shall not be refunded in any case.
- Downloaded application form, complete in all respects along with necessary enclosures / documents must be submitted on or before the last date published in the advertisement or on the

website of Jaipur National University Institute for Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Jaipur .

### Admission Application form shall stand rejected, if

- The form is received after the last date. Delay on the part of postal Courier will not be considered.
- Form is incomplete / wrongly filled in.
- Necessary Enclosures are not attached.
- Not filled in as per the given directions.
- Received without cost of the application form.
- Candidates who fall short of the prescribed age limit for admission.
- Candidates who fail to obtain the minimum stipulated marks in the qualifying examination (Higher Secondary or + 2).



- Candidates who have applied under Non-Creamy Layer OBC Category and whose sub-caste NOT listed in the current Central OBC List and who's Certificate has NOT been submitted in the prescribed format duly issued by Competent Authority.
- The candidates who have applied under SC/ST Categories WITHOUT valid Certificate as in the prescribed format duly signed by the Competent Authority.
- Non submission of OCI Registration Certificate issued by Competent Authority.
- Non Production of Provisional Student Visa for NRI / OCI candidates.

#### **Instructions for Filling the Application Form**

- Forms must be filled in by the candidate in his / her own handwriting neatly and legibly in English using capital letters, except for signature.
- Overwriting, cutting, erasing in the form may lead to rejection and should be avoided.
- Any discrepancy in the statement and / or submission of

incomplete forms will lead to rejection of application / cancellation of admission.

- Recent coloured passport size photograph of the candidate must be pasted at appropriate place on the application. The photograph must be signed by the candidate at the edge and should not be defaced.
- Name of the Applicant must be written in capital letters as it appears in the marks sheet of the Secondary School (Class-X) examination.
- Name of the Parent / Guardian: Write the name of parent/ guardian.
- Candidate and the Parent/ guardian must sign with date the declarations and undertakings to authenticate the information provided by them as per format on a self attested non judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/-
- Write the month and year, School / College and board / University from where you have passed or appeared for 10+2 or equivalent examination.
- Subject-wise maximum marks of 10+2: Write maximum marks, marks obtained and the percentage in the appropriate columns.



### LIST OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

- Allotment letter obtained after counseling of NEET.
- Pass certificate of the qualifying examination.
- Statement of marks of the qualifying examination.
- Age Certificate showing the date of birth (Birth Certificate or X Std. Certificate).
- Character and Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institute last studied (Bonafide Certificate)
- Residence Certificate issued by Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tahsildar.
- In case of Other Backward Classes / Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe, a Community Certificate, recently obtained from the competent authority - a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar.
- Other Backward Classes (OBC) candidates should produce the required certificate as per the format in the Annexure along with last three years Income Tax returns of the parents/ Annual Income certificate in case parents are not employed.

- Transfer Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied.
- Medical Certificate in case of Orthopedic Physically Challenged Candidates.
- Recent Passport size colour photographs.
- One set of attested photocopies of all the original certificates.

### NRI SEATS

**In addition to above :** Recent NRI Status certificate of the parent or candidate issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective Country with the Embassy seal.

### OVERSEAS CITIZEN OF INDIA (OCI)

**In addition to above:** Certificate of Registration for Overseas Citizen of India.

**NOTE:** If any of the above original certificates are found defective, the candidate shall not be deemed eligible for admission. If the certificates are in any other language, except English, English Translation attested by a Gazetted Officer should be produced.







# Conduct

&

# Discipline

A student shall maintain high standards of discipline within and outside the premises of the institute, in a manner befitting the students of an institution of quality academic and ethical values. Students are expected to abide by the following instructions failing which they are liable to be punished by the concerned authority.

1. Students will be held solely responsible for any damage or loss to hostel property including furniture, electrical fittings etc. provided in their rooms.
2. Mess facilities have been made available to all students, thus all students are expected to have their meals at the prescribed time in mess, Taking meals in rooms is not permitted.
3. Students shall show due courtesy and consideration to the employees of the Institute and hostel. Any complaint against any mess employee(s) must be brought to the notice of warden immediately.
4. Before leaving the institutional campus students are required to obtain permission & write their names and addresses in the register maintained for the purpose.
5. No female shall be allowed to enter the hostel/ rooms except the guest room in boys hostel and vice versa. No male is allowed in the girls hostel/ rooms.
6. Consumption of intoxicating/narcotic drugs or alcohol is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be taken against those found in possession of such items and a fine will be imposed.
7. Possession of lethal weapons or arms shall invite his/her expulsion from College without any enquiry.
8. College holds no responsibility against loss or theft of any personal expensive items.
9. Entry of stranger/ friend/ relation/ unauthorized person in his/her room is strictly prohibited and any student found doing so shall be liable for serious action including expulsion from the hostel.



10. No student shall be absent from the hostel without written permission of the warden. Students wishing to visit friends / relatives allowed by parents, even on holidays, shall obtain prior written permission of the warden.
11. All residents of hostel are expected to be back in their hostels latest by 8 pm.
12. Students are expected to reach their respective hostels at the stipulated time and sign the register kept for the purpose on entry, which will be checked periodically.
13. Local outings must be intimated to the authority concerned and prior permission must be obtained along with details of check out & check in timings failing which disciplinary action will be taken.
14. Entry of male relatives inside girls hostel is strictly prohibited. Entry is restricted to visitor's room.
15. Female relatives and friends are allowed in girls hostel but not beyond 8 pm.
16. Any student found violating any of the above instructions/ rules shall render himself/herself to disciplinary action before the committee.
17. Students absent from the hostel without obtaining night passes would also invite disciplinary action, against them.
18. The Principal & Controller of the Institute would decide regulations on matter not included above.
19. A candidate selected for admission shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the Institution.
20. If any candidate/authorized representative or accompanying person is found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner/creating nuisance then the candidates shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the institution in this respect shall be final and binding as well.

## Anti Ragging Measures

Ragging is a cognizable offence and is forbidden in any form. Anyone indulging in ragging will be punished severely as per the relevant regulations of the MCI and the provisions of the Act of the Central Government and the State Government.

### The Supreme Court has defined the ragging as under

Clause No. 6: Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or

psyche of a fresher or a junior student. The cause of indulging in ragging is deriving a sadistic pleasure or showing off, power, authority or superiority by the seniors over their juniors or fresher's.

### Punishable ingredients of Ragging

- Abetment of ragging;
- Criminal Conspiracy to rag;
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- Public nuisance created during ragging;
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;

- Wrongful restraint;
- Wrongful Confinement;
- Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences;
- Extortion;
- Criminal trespass;
- Offences against property;
- Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation.

Each student is required to give an undertaking in printed Proforma to the effect that he / she is aware of the law regarding prohibition of ragging as well as the punishment and further that he / she has not been expelled and / or debarred from admission by any institution and he / she if found guilty of the offence of ragging and / or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately including even arrest by Police.

### PUNISHMENTS

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ exam or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional,

national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

- Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters.
- Expulsion from the Institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment
